



BOSTON – Thursday, April 11, 2017 – La Alianza Hispana, the longest serving Latino Agency across the greater Boston region, today announced its relocation to ensure the long-term success of the organization and continuation in delivering quality services for families and individuals.

On Monday, March 06, 2017, La Alianza moved its Healthy Families Program and Administration, which has been temporarily located at 434 Warren Street in Boston, to a new, permanent location at 1000 Massachusetts Avenue in Boston. La Alianza’s Adult Day Health and Senior Center, which were located at 63 Parker Hill Avenue in Boston, also moved to this new location.

“This new location will allow La Alianza to expand its Adult Day Health and Senior Center as well as its Healthy Families Program. I am so grateful to our Board of Directors and other community partners who have helped us identify a new location and provided technical expertise during the build-out phase.” said Marisol Amaya-Aluigi, executive director of La Alianza. “While we loved our location in Roxbury, our building needed very expensive repairs and we felt our priority was to invest those funds in our people and our community.”

Founded over 40 years ago, La Alianza Hispana has served Latino communities in Boston as well as all residents in the surrounding neighborhoods of Dorchester, Roxbury, Jamaica Plain, Hyde Park, Roslindale, West Roxbury, Mattapan, East Boston and other nearby cities such as Chelsea and Lawrence. The organization provides a vital set of educational, health and workforce training services enabling individuals and families to realize their personal, educational, and economic needs and goals.

“We are doing everything to ensure that La Alianza’s high-quality services are not interrupted during this time,” said Amaya-Aluigi. “We are very excited about our future, and our relocation will further secure our long-term financial health.”

The Grand opening at La Alianza’s new location at 1000 Massachusetts Avenue suite 101 in Boston is being planned for May 2017 from 1 pm to 3 pm.
